**CHURCH OFFICES** will be closed Thursday, November 25, and Friday, November 26, in celebration of Thanksgiving.

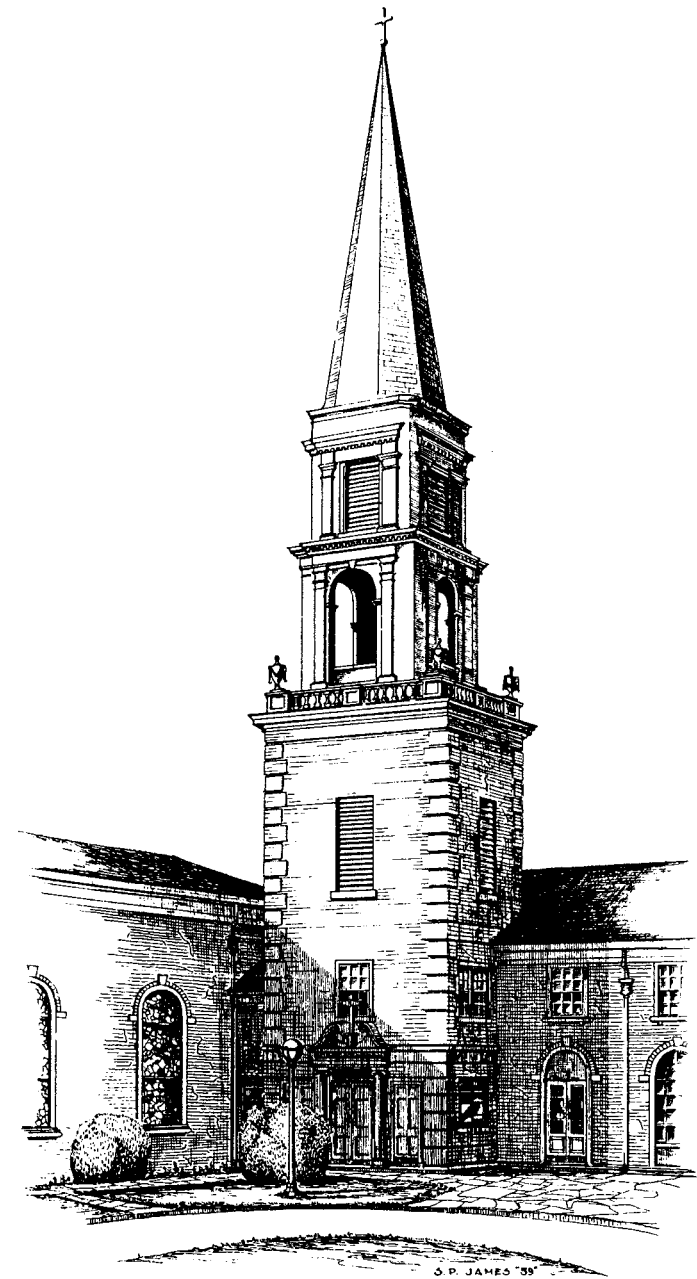
**FIRST PRESBYTERIAN/ST. JOHN'S EPISCOPAL/ PEAKLAND UMC
