YOUTH SUNDAY SCHOOL offerings for the month of April will go to Summer Camp - Jubilee Family Development Center.

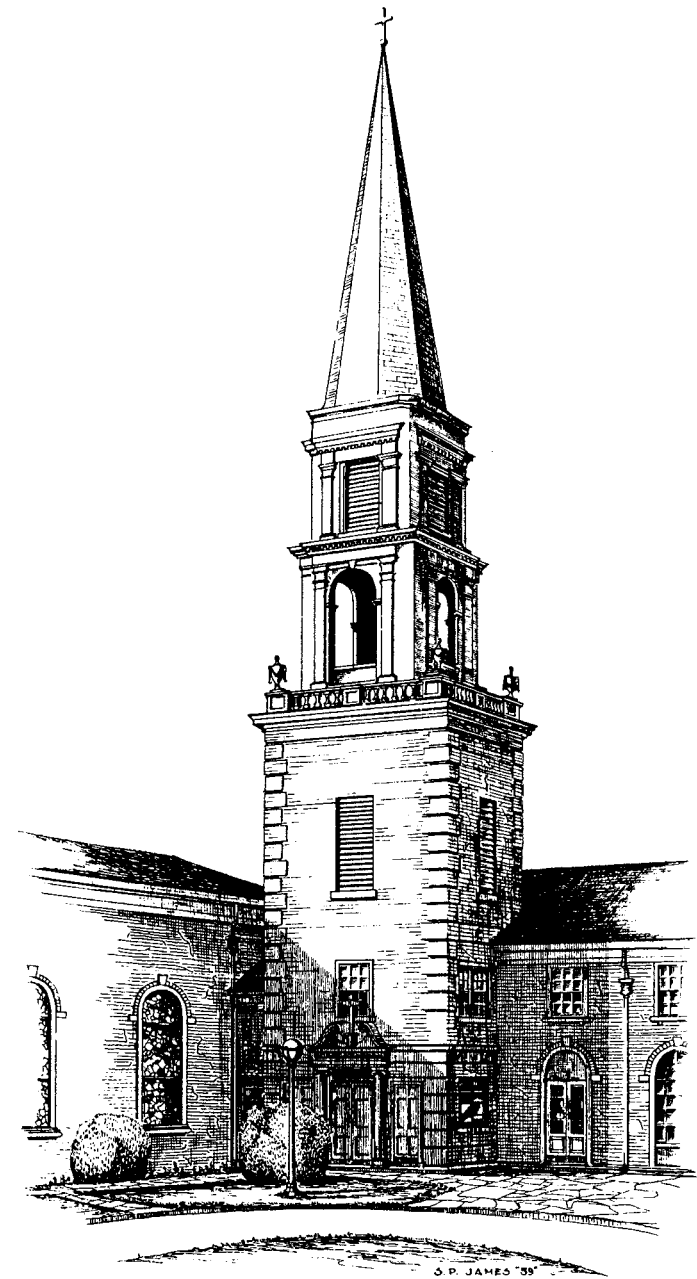
