April 12, 2020

"Easter" comes from an Old English word related to dawn and shining. At Easter, we stand in light of the resurrection to see a new creation, transformed by the grace and glory of God, and celebrate the presence and power of the risen Christ in his church by proclaiming his good news and rejoicing in the gift of the Holy Spirit, who is the "Lord and giver of life." Theologically, the faith we claim and the life we live depend on the affirmation, celebration, and proclamation of Christ's resurrection.
