#### "Rooted and Reaching" Capital Project Update:

- 1. We have now raised over \$2.65 Million in pledges to date! Just under \$350,000 shy of our goal \$3 Million to do everything outlined in the Campaign Focus. Booklets and Brochures with more information are available in the church office.
- The Steeple Replacement project is underway led by Bill Perkins and Sutton Tinsley. Construction is underway behind the scenes and starting Monday, April 5<sup>th</sup>, deconstruction of the current steeple will begin.
- 3. The Organ Renovation project has been affirmed by Session, contracted with Foley-Baker, and will be led by Rob Cleland and Cory Whittier. The initial stages of the renovation are scheduled to begin this summer with construction to start early in 2022. The construction phase will be 12 to 14 months from start to finish.
- 4. Session has approved that \$50,000 designated for Ministry Support will be dedicated to the support of hiring new staff to help build relationships through educational and outreach opportunities.
- 5. All other projects outlined in the campaign focus are in planning stages with more information to come.

**Office and Facility Update:** Session has approved the opening of offices and facilities back for small groups and committee meetings. Please contact the church office to reserve space and time. All who attend are asked to continue with wearing masks, signing in, and following all check-in protocols. Session continues to reassess local Covid impact and looks to begin plans for reopening the Sanctuary for worship soon.

**New Entrance to Office:** This week construction for the steeple will be taking place in the front circle over the main entrance. All who come to the church office are asked to enter through the Columbarium gates. As you enter the outside gates, please proceed to the set of double glass doors and not one of the single doors entering the Narthex. **Note: The Church Office will be closed for the Easter Holiday on Monday, April 5.**
