"Rooted and Reaching" Capital Project Update:

- We have now raised over \$2.65 Million in pledges to date! Just under \$350,000 shy of our goal of \$3 Million to do everything outlined in the Campaign Focus. Booklets and Brochures with more information are available in the church office.
- 2. The Steeple Replacement project is underway led by Bill Perkins and Sutton Tinsley. This week, the steeple was removed in three parts. We have kept the cross from the top of the spire. We look forward to early May when the new steeple will be put into place! Stay tuned for details on a steeple dedication!
- 3. The Organ Renovation project has been affirmed by Session and contracted with Foley-Baker. Rob Cleland and Cory Whittier are serving as project coordinators. Members from the Foley-Baker team were in the organ chambers last week taking measurements and working in the space. Construction is scheduled to start early in 2022. The construction phase will be 12 to 14 months from start to finish.
- 4. Other projects are in the planning stages with more information to come.

Annual Stewardship Campaign Status: We have now received 185 pledges totaling close to \$634,000 for our 2021 Operating Budget! Thank you to all who have turned in their pledge. Annual Stewardship packets and pledge cards were passed out concurrently with the Capital Projects Campaign visits, so if we have missed you in any way, please know that was not our intention and let us know.
