
























# Sermon Bingo!

## Instructions:

- Mark the words as you hear them. You can mark the word if the suffix changes (-ing, -es, -ed, etc.) but not with a prefix change (re-, un-, in-, mis-, etc.).
- Words must be **spoken within the sermon** itself, which begins after the scripture readings. *(Usually it ends with "This is the Word of God for the people of God. Thanks be to God.")*
- There may be multiple ways to get bingo, so listen to the entire sermon! And while there's no guarantee, if you do get bingo, let Peter and/or Kathleen know after worship!
- On the lines provided, write a summarizing phrase, sentence, or message from the sermon or a memorable quote from the sermon. OR write a question to ask after worship so you can remember to ask after!

- **Wisdom:** the quality of having experience, knowledge, and good judgment; the quality of being wise.
- **Action:** the fact or process of doing something, typically to achieve an aim (pictured is a clapperboard used on movie/TV sets when actors begin their scene)
- **Faith:** complete trust or confidence in something or someone; strong belief in God
- **Embody:** be an example of expression of an idea, belief, feeling, etc.; internalize a teaching
- **Grace:** another word for a blessing before a meal (which is represented in the picture); grace is a spontaneous gift from God to people—it is generous, free, unexpected, and underserved
- **Hope:** a feeling of expectation and desire for something; a feeling of trust; an anchor is a Christian symbol for hope and steadfastness with the source being *Hebrews 6:19*, “*Which hope we have as an anchor of the soul...*”
