- Community: a feeling of fellowship with others as a result of sharing common attitudes, interests, and goals; FPCLY is a community of faith
- Call: a verbal communication; summoning attention from someone or something; in a Christian sense: we believe that each person has a reason—a purpose or part to play—as a singular part of the Body of Christ; vocation
- **Trinity:** God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit; the Christian Godhead as one God in three persons or parts
- **Mission:** an important assignment given to complete; in the Christian sense: the act of serving or the purpose we are "called" to live out
