

























# Sermon Bingo!

- **Theology:** the study of the nature of God and religious belief
- **Soul:** the spiritual or invisible part of a being; emotional or brain energy of a person or thing
- **Participate:** take part in action or endeavor; join in actively
- **Wilderness:** a neglected or abandoned property or place; a feeling of displacement or being without direction
- **Communion:** in our Christian context, it is the service of worship where bread and wine are consecrated (blessed) and shared, remembering Jesus's ultimate sacrifice for us on the cross
- **Kingdom:** in our Christian context, the spiritual reign or authority of God
