



Adjacent to historic Diamond Hill, Presbyterian Cemetery was founded in 1823 by six elders from the local Presbyterian churches. The land, located on Grace Street, was purchased from the founding family of Lynchburg. The cemetery has served the memorial needs of our changing community, with the clear purpose of providing a beautiful and secure burial setting for Lynchburg and the surrounding area.

Presbyterian Cemetery has the charm and park-like atmosphere found only in planned cemeteries of the past, providing a visual history of people and times.



One might have seen families strolling through the cemetery with children playing amongst the graves and enjoying picnics at family plots. The Cemetery's trustees continue to be committed to providing personal service and the utmost in grounds care. This outdoor museum has some of the most unique and elaborate tombstones, monuments and memorials in the area. Nonprofit and nonsectarian from the beginning, the cemetery still has individual and family spaces available.

We are fully operational and ready to meet your needs, offering more than 2,000 burial plots, two beautiful Columbaria, and numerous distinctive memorials.



There are more than 600 veterans buried at the Cemetery, as well as a section dedicated to Lynchburg's Firefighters.


