

## Malawi Update, September 2021

FPCLY has partnered with the village communities of Kalikumbi, Embangweni, and Mtzuzu for over 20 years after the late Harold Riley (and his wife Barbara) began organizing mission teams. Earlier this year, FPCLY shared financial resources with the church in Kalikumbi led by Reverend Bright. The resources were for the creation of facemasks for COVID protection for students in the schools and bible study groups of the church; the funds also provided support to purchase seed and materials to plant soybeans and sunflower seeds to prevent food insecurity as a result of the pandemic. Thanks to significant rain over the first part of the year the harvest was bountiful over the summer. Let us pray this fall as the Malawians begin to prepare the fields and plant for the next growing season.



Children, youth, and adults in Malawi had the opportunity for COVID-19 protection due to some of your financial gifts to FPCLY.

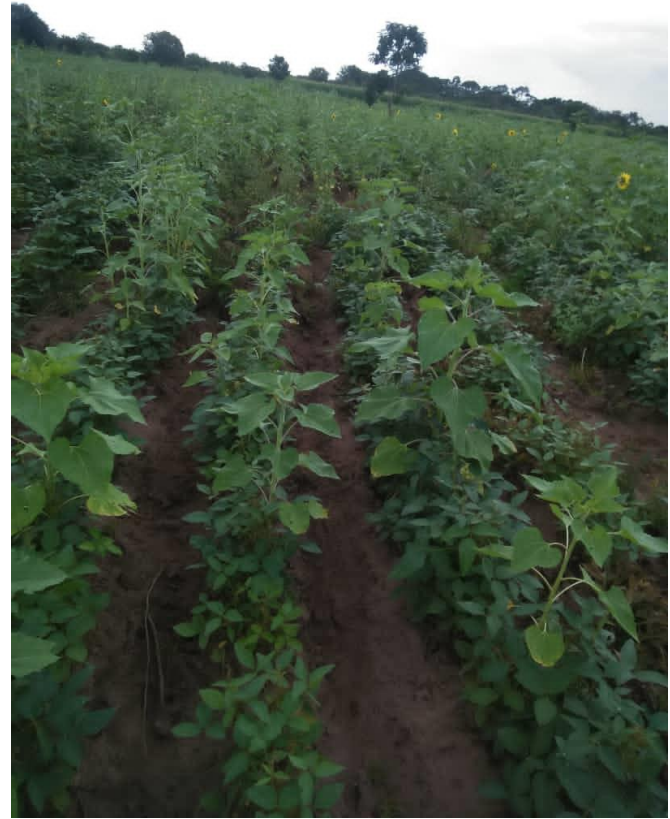
Thru funds we shared, the church was able to produce over 800 masks offered FREE to the school and church community!
