



Family and Friends of FPCLY!

Your Session met last night to review the status of our response to COVID and make any necessary changes. They approved changes as detailed below that will keep us moving forward in celebrating and inspiring together!

From February 2 (today) through February 16, 2022, normal church operations are resumed with specific COVID precautions in place.

Precautions:

- Facial masks will be REQUIRED. Masks will be available to all who enter the church and Ushers and/or staff will enforce their use.
- No specific requirement for social distancing will exist; persons should use their own judgment.
- Disinfectant will be available and recommended, but not required.
- Worship leadership & choir are not required to be masked in the worship setting.
- FPCLY encourages the vaccination of all eligible persons but cannot require or enforce it.

Normal church operations include, but are not limited to In-person Worship, In-person Worship+2 activities, and In-person meetings, rehearsals, and gatherings.

Remote participation via live radio broadcasts, streaming, and Zoom will continue to be offered as an option for those who prefer or require it.

Starting February 17, 2022, the same precautions will apply with the exception that facial masking will be RECOMMENDED, not REQUIRED.
