



And why have you become disturbed within me? Hope in God, for I shall again praise Him for the help of His presence.








God has given us His very great and precious promises so that through them you may participate in the divine nature.

Who are the heroes of the faith listed in Hebrews 11:7-34?


Why are they listed as heroes?






Because of God's promises, they became heirs to the Kingdom.

Matthew 8:5-11

When Jesus had entered Capernaum, a centurion came to him, asking for help. "Lord," he said, "my servant lies at home paralyzed, suffering terribly." Jesus said to him, "Shall I come and heal him?" The centurion replied, "Lord, I do not deserve to have you come under my roof. But just say the word, and my servant will be healed. For I myself am a man under authority, with soldiers under me. I tell this one, 'Go,' and he goes; and that one, 'Come,' and he comes. I say to my servant, 'Do this,' and he does it." When Jesus heard this, he was amazed and said to those following him, "Truly I tell you, I have not found anyone in Israel with such great faith. I say to you that many will come from the east and the west, and will take their places at the feast with Abraham,


Isaac and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven.

In this first Chapter, we have read that God keeps His promises.


Right now, in your life, is it easy to believe that God will keep His promises?

How could remembering the way that God has kept His promises in the past, give you have that He will keep them now and in the future?








People of the Promise
