

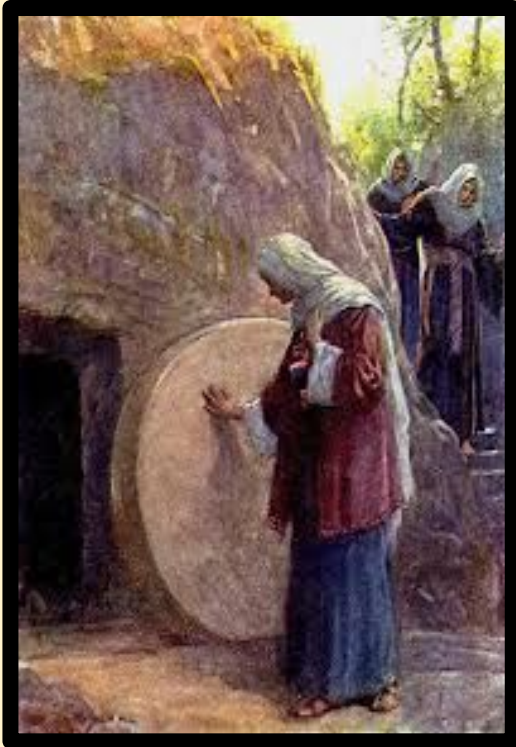

the place where he lay."

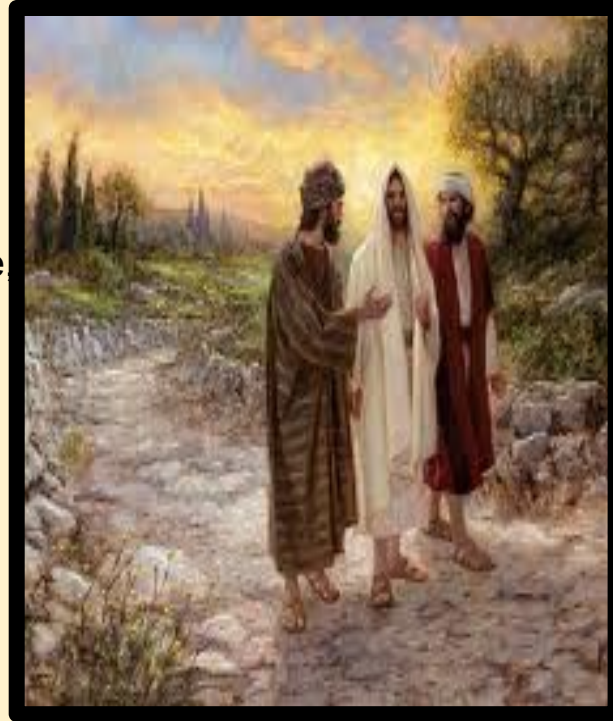

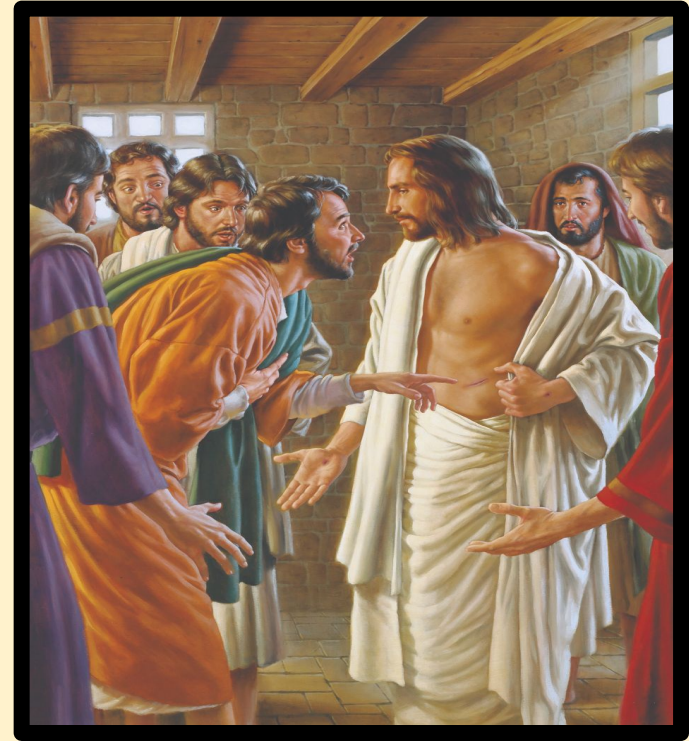


He appeared to

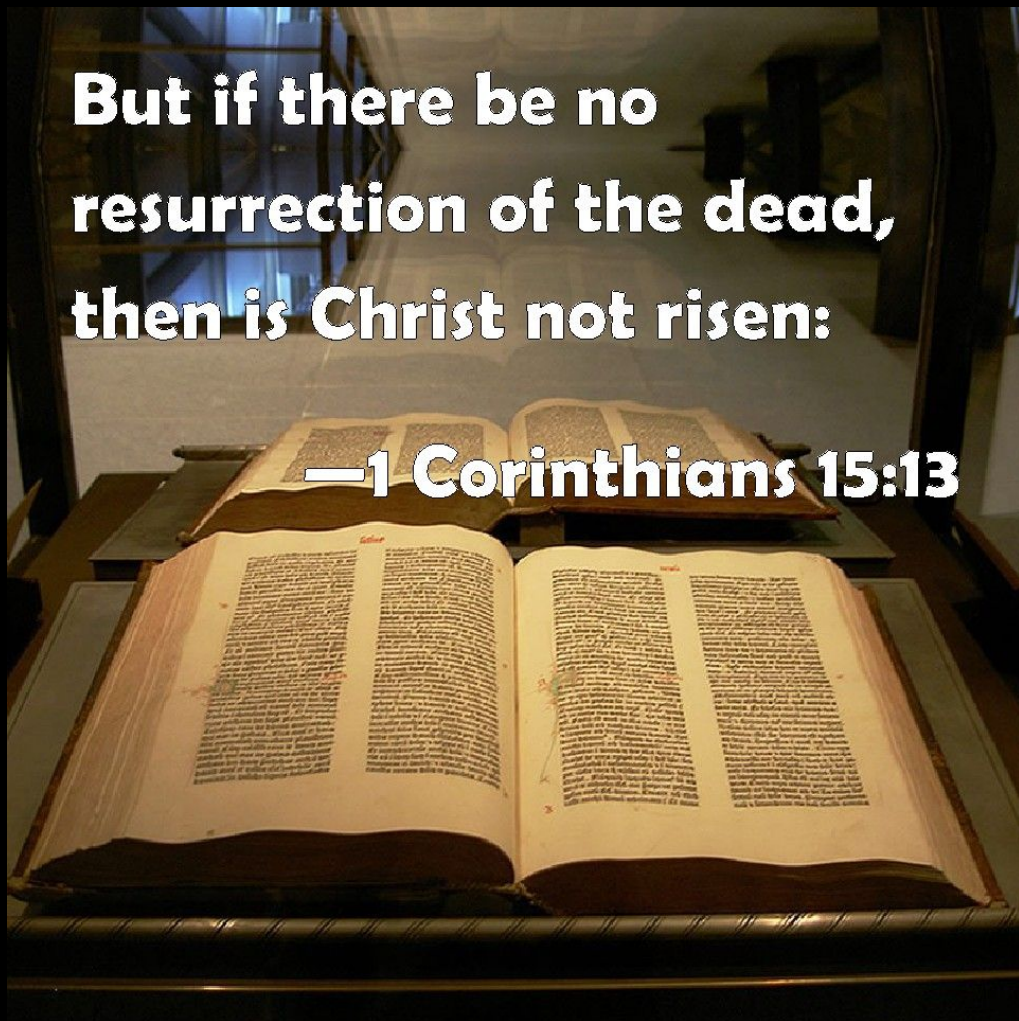

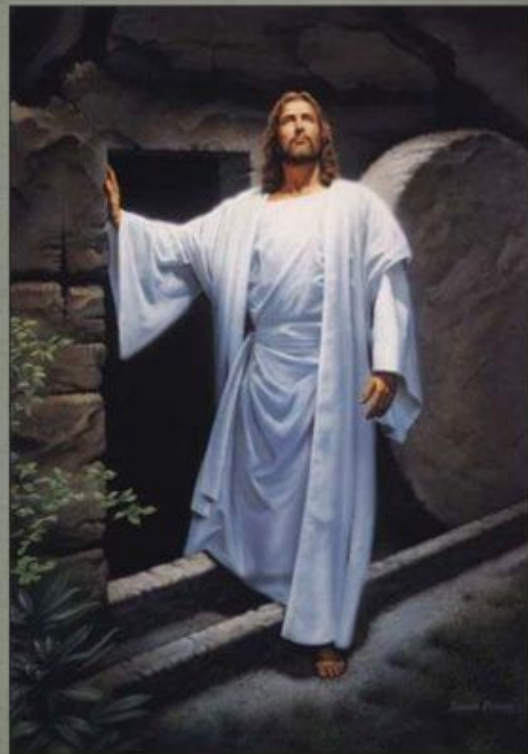

It is sown a perishable *body*, it is raised an imperishable *body*;


it is sown in dishonor, it is raised in glory;


