Do you see Jesus as a judge also?




"For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things done in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad."


~ 2 Corinthians 5:10

Why do you think the Lord wants to have a public pardon of our sins?






This idea of both Justice and Judgement is a double-edged sword.

Jesus will applaud the service of His servants.



Our just God recognizes faithful stewardship.


God is not unjust; he will not forget your work and the love you have shown him as you have helped his people and continue to help them. Hebrews 6:10
