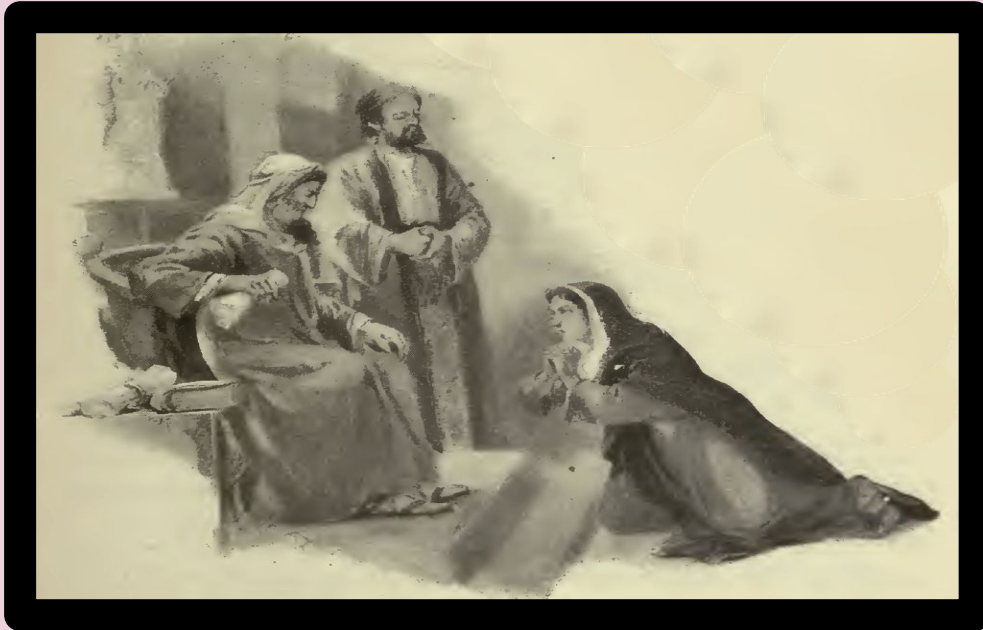

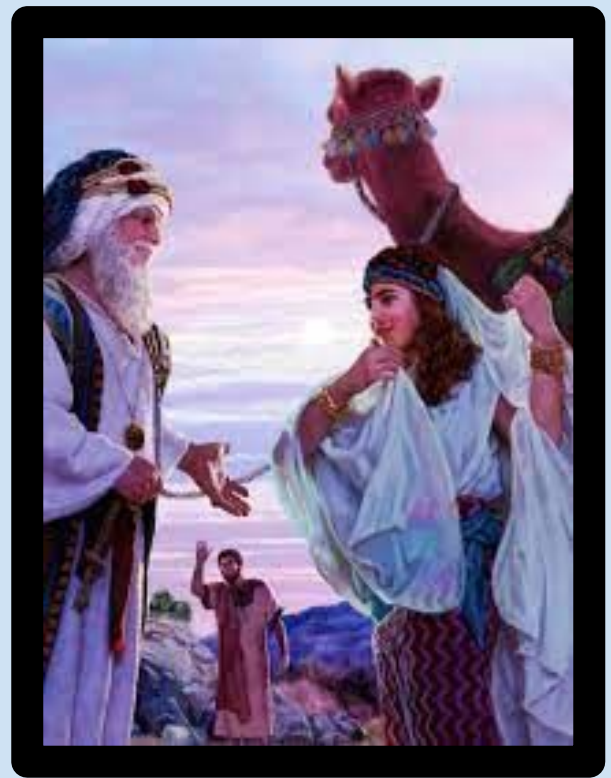
How is the blind man's faith evident in this interaction?

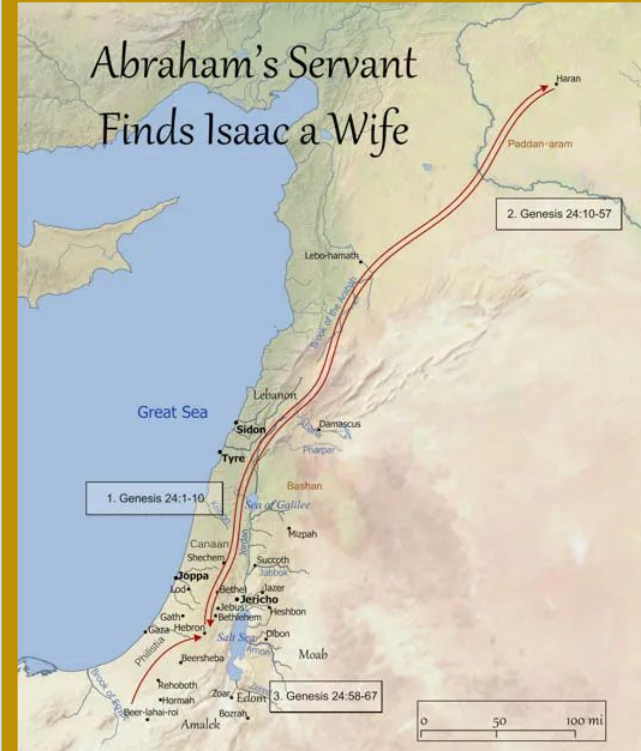

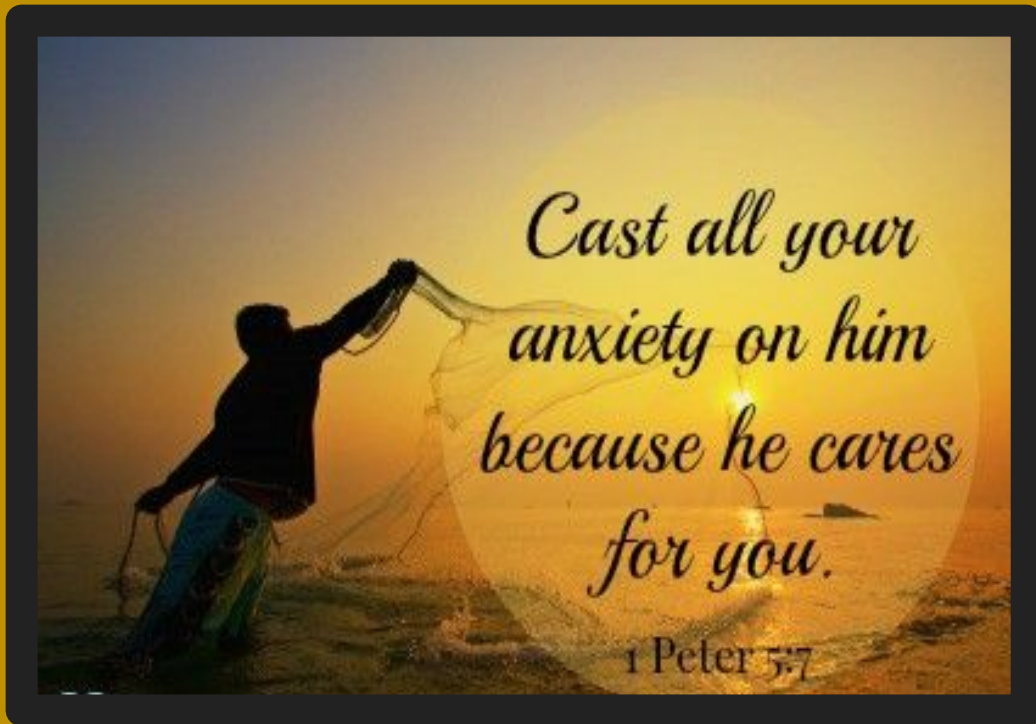
