




Luke tells us that Martha was 'distracted.'


How did her concern lead her to treat Jesus and her sister?


What happens when you focus on your concerns?




What does each of these verses say about the mission of our enemy?






What does this verse say that our minds have the power to do?

When the source of your anxiety is a reality, make a list of other truths that are good -Lay claim to every biblical promise you can remember and set out to learn a few more






What things strike you about God in Psalm 8?

Psalm 8

- ² You have taught children and infants to tell of your strength, silencing your enemies and all who oppose you.
- ³ When I look at the night sky and see the work of your fingers the moon and the stars you set in place -
- ⁴ what are mere mortals that you should think about them, human beings that you should care for them?
- ⁵ Yet you made them only a little lower than God and crowned them with glory and honor.
- ⁶ You have them charge of everything you made, putting all things under their authority.
- ⁷ the flocks and the herds and all the wild animals,
- ⁸ the birds in the sky, the fish in the sea, and everything that swims the ocean currents.
- ⁹ O Lord, our Lord, your majestic name fills the earth.
