From 2021 to 2022, First Presbyterian Church welcomed 35 new pledge and giving units that were added to a generous foundation of historical givers. Together they helped bolster new and exciting opportunities of ministry among us. As we look toward 2023, the power and presence of the Holy Spirit continues to call us forward in opportunities of relationship and discipleship. Whether it is...

- Developing the lives of children through the FPC Weekday School, Sunday morning Worship Workshops, or Vacation Bible School;
- Enjoying singing and praise of music through the Chancel Choir and First Pres Presents Fine Arts Series;
- Offering care and nurture to the hospitalized and home centered;
- Benevolence and service to a community partner agency or national and global partner;
- Partaking in faith and relationship building opportunities within the church including all ages;

The magnitude of God's calling to First Presbyterian Church of Lynchburg to operate in 2023 is outlined more fully in the enclosed *Narrative Budget*, which total costs north of \$1.1 Million. There are three significant highlights to note with the Narrative Budget.

- 1. The costs associated to each ministry represent demand aspirations in line with where God is calling First Presbyterian Church to go; doing what God calls and trusting God provides. This is a slight change from years past when the budget has been developed on a supply method; doing what can be done with what is given.
- 2. The work and call of the church are structured in four main ministry areas: Worship, Education, Outreach, and Resources. These four ministry areas align with the new Session structure of leadership as they hold the work and call of the church in discernment.
- 3. Personnel expenses are not included as its own focus. The reason for this is because all the Personnel in the church are called to help support and lead one or more of the four main ministries. Therefore, the annual Personnel budget is allocated by percentage to the different ministries in which the staff serve.

 - ONE-TIME GIFT GIVING: Pledging is helpful for planning, however, giving when able is also a faithful way to generously give to God and God's church. The time of offering during worship provides all who are worshipping the opportunity to respond to the good news of God and giving during this time is encouraged and welcome.
 - PLANNED/ ESTATE GIFTS: Much of how First Presbyterian Church is able to do what it does today is because of gifts dedicated in generosity many years ago. Information on how to include First Presbyterian Church of Lynchburg in your financial trust or will is available upon request.
- <u>Pledge Leadership</u> using your God-given gifts and skills to help foster and support the operations and ministries of First Presbyterian. This is also known as giving of your time and talents.
- ✓ <u>Pledge Presence and Participation</u> in worship, education, and outreach ministry opportunities.
