Read Acts 1:1-11 and Luke 24:50-53



Luke is writing to Theophilus so that he will share the Gospel accounts with the Gentiles.

In all of the Gospels we find the stories of how Jesus came to show God's love, and to teach.

His apostles were to carry on and continue what Jesus began, and to do and teach the same things.

The timing of this evangelical story is fixed *to the day in which Jesus was taken up.* He taught them until the very end. He told them that he was sending them His Holy Spirit. Then he left this world, and His bodily presence was no more in it.







The truth of Christ's Resurrection is maintained.

He was seen by different apostles across 40 days, appearing to them in many ways.

Jesus walked with them and ate and drank with them.

He showed them His crucifixion wounds.



As Jesus appeared to the apostles, *He breathed on them* and *opened their understandings,* so they were better able to receive His expectations.
