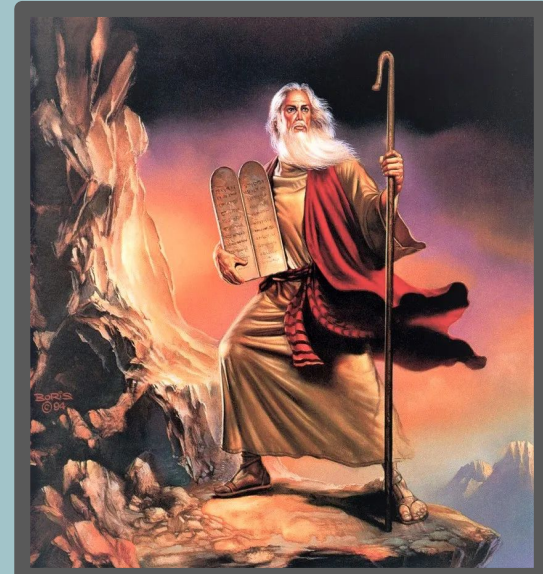
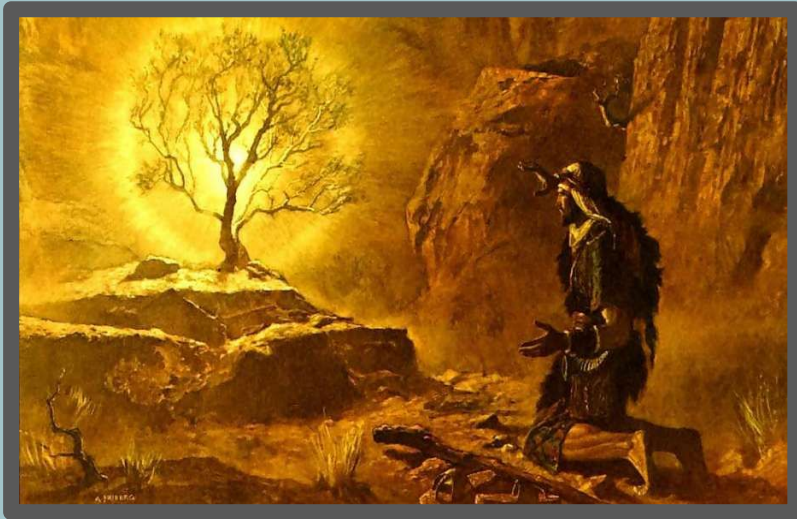

On behalf of Israel, Moses received torah, traditionally translated 'law'. This is not law in the modern sense but rather authoritative teaching, instruction, or guidance. The most famous of these commandments are **the Ten Commandments.**



Elijah was a 9th century bc Hebrew prophet. He denounced Israel's foreign cults and defeated 450 prophets of Baal in a contest on Mount Carmel. In doing so, he earned the hatred of King Ahab and his consort, Jezebel, who made him fear for his life and flee into the wilderness.

God spoke to him and sent him back to work.



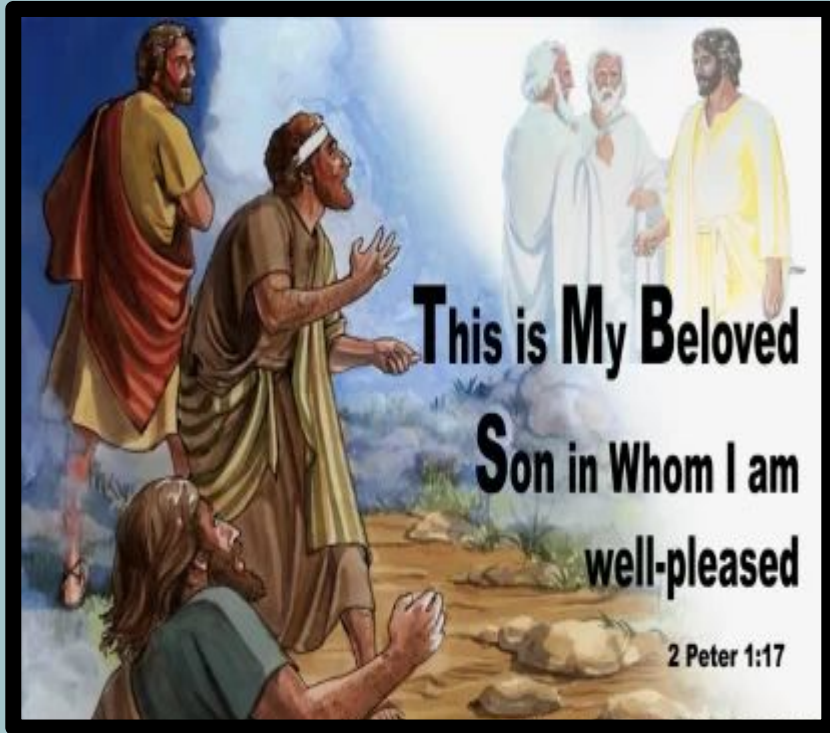

Elijah could have done much more impressive feats on earth, but God took him home early, in a chariot no less.

We do know that the prophet Malachi said Elijah would come before “the great and dreadful day of the Lord” (Malachi 4:5) to prepare people for the coming of the Messiah.



It was while the Lord Jesus was speaking with Moses and Elijah, who were conversing with Him about His fast approaching sacrificial death at Calvary and His own 'exodus' from this life into His resurrected glory, that: "Suddenly a bright cloud covered them." The three astonished observers then heard the voice of the Almighty God of Israel, Creator of heaven and earth: "This is My beloved Son. I take delight in Him. Listen to Him," was the heavenly command.
